


How was an Egyptian kingdom like a community?

civilisation		A well-developed society with its own government, laws and culture.
ancient		Belonging to the very distant past and having been in existence for a very long time.
artefacts		An object that is made by a person
archaeologist		A person who studies buildings, graves, tools and objects of people who lived in the past.
Tutankhamun		A pharaoh known as the 'boy king' as he became a pharaoh aged 9.
pyramid		A stone, triangular tomb where pharaohs were buried.
tomb		A large stone structure where an important person is buried.
reliability		How trustworthy a source of information is.
timeline		A tool to show events in history in chronological order.
BC AD		BC - Before Christ BCE - Before the Common Era AD - After Birth of Christ CE - Common Era
kingdom		A country ruled by a king or queen (pharaoh).
pharaoh		A ruler of ancient Egypt.

Wise Owl Knowledge

Ancient Egypt is one of the World's first civilisations that grew up along the River Nile (4500 BC – 332 BC on our timeline).

There were 3 main periods:

- The Old Kingdom known as the Age of the Pyramids. The Great Pyramids were built.
- The Middle Kingdom, which was a time of building and construction, was the Egyptian 'Golden Age'.
- The New Kingdom which was a time of changing beliefs (Rameses). Tutankhamun ruled during this time.
